

POLICIES For Student Athletes

The basic principal of conduct under which we will operate at Brenham Junior High School is to:

Conduct yourself in such a manner that you bring credit to yourself, your teammates, your family and to Brenham Junior High School. Never engage in any activity that can be construed as inappropriate for a Brenham Junior High School athletic team member.

Disciplinary Action:

Dismissal from your current team, or from all other Brenham Junior High School athletic teams could result from serious infraction to these policies.

1. Drinking and smoking will be considered “breaking training”. An athlete that receives a M. I. P. also falls under breaking training.
 - **1st Offense** – The athlete will run 5 miles a day for 20 days and cannot play in an athletic contest until punishment is completed. This is punishment for breaking training. (Disciplinary Reasons)
 - **2nd Offense** – Suspension for 1 full calendar year.
 - **3rd Offense** – Suspension forever.
2. School contests come first. If you miss a game in order to play an out of school contest or practice, then you need to choose one to be involved in.
3. If you must miss athletics, talk to your coach prior to missing the workout to discuss the make up that will be required.
4. How we present ourselves is extremely important.
 - No facial hair.
 - No unusual haircuts that draws attention to an individual. (dyed hair, mohawks, dred locks, etc.)
 - No earring(s) (males only).
 - If cap is worn, it must be a BRENHAM cap.
 - Always present ourselves in a manner of the highest class.
5. Unsportsman-like conduct will not be tolerated. The decision will be made by each individual coach as to the punishment.
6. Stealing from your teammates, or from other schools, is unacceptable and is also punishable by suspension from the team.
7. Always be on time to practices, games and for travel arrangements.
8. Treat your coaches with respect and they will return that same respect to you. Be sure to have eye contact with your coach when being spoken to.
9. A student-athlete assigned to ISS or AEP will not be allowed to participate in their next athletic event.
